

## LEARN MORE ABOUT COLEGIO CRISTIANO PRESBITERIANO

**Colegio Cristiano Presbiteriano (CCP)** was founded in 1996 by the Mission of the Presbyterian Church of South Korea in Nicaragua.

It is in Hialeah Barrio in Managua, a very poor community. Classes are offered for pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and grades 1 – 11. (The final grade in Nicaragua is the 11th grade.) The school has just under 400 students.

Pablo and Sarah Kim, South Korean missionaries, have operated CCP since 2014. Sarah is the Director of the school. Under the Kims' leadership the school has been expanded from only offering classes through sixth grade to providing a full secondary curriculum. The physical campus has been improved. Also, an AWANA program (an evangelical program in which students are introduced to, and nurtured in, their Christian faith through a stimulating, educational, and community-building club format) is being provided for interested students. The number of students at CCP continues to increase each year. This is evidence of the value that Nicaraguan parents place on the opportunities and environment offered by CCP.

### **How You Can Help**

Students pay a small tuition, but the majority of the funding for the operational costs of the school (salaries, utilities, supplies, etc.) comes from donations. **Austin Samaritans is one of the primary donors providing support for the school. Without its support, the school would close.** Austin Samaritans is aided in providing this support by individuals who share the vision that CCP can change the trajectory of the lives of its students by providing a sound education in a Christian environment.

You are invited to become one of those individuals by becoming a sponsor. Sponsorship provides economically disadvantaged children an opportunity to receive a quality education, Christian witness, and the care and concern of loving teachers and staff.

Sponsorship is an opportunity for you to have a more insightful understanding of how your giving supports and impacts disadvantaged children in Nicaragua. You will have a more meaningful connection to the lives of these students.

Sponsors send donations on a monthly, quarterly, or annual basis. You may choose to be a student sponsor, a class sponsor, or a general school sponsor.

**Student sponsors** will have an opportunity to become acquainted with an individual student and follow his/her progress through school.

- The suggested gift to sponsor a student is \$50 monthly, \$150 quarterly, or \$600 annually.
- You can select your student and if you wish, you can specify age and gender.
- Student sponsors will receive biographical information about their student, updated annually.

**Class sponsors** will be provided information about the students in a class and their school activities. Sponsorship will begin with a kindergarten class and will follow that class as it progresses through subsequent grades.

- The suggested gift to sponsor a class is \$100 monthly, \$300 quarterly, or \$1200 annually.
- Sponsorship will begin with a kindergarten class and remain with that class as it progresses to subsequent grades.
- Information provided will include class photos, information about individual students in the class, biographical information and a photo of the teacher, and periodic updates about class activities and events.

**General school sponsors** will receive information on overall conditions and activities at the school.

- The suggested gift to be a general school sponsor is \$50 monthly, \$150 quarterly, or \$600 annually.
- General sponsors will receive periodic information about events and developments at the school.
